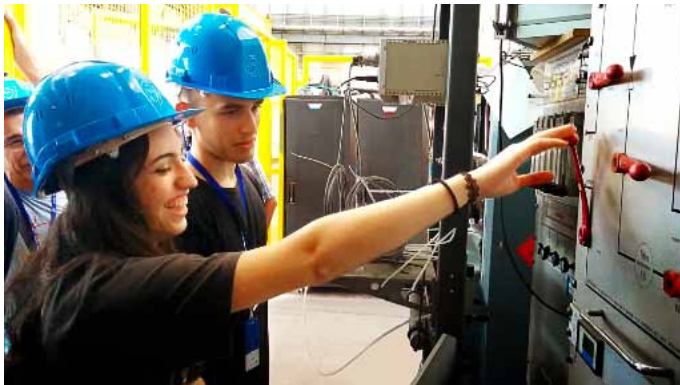

What are the Providence STEM Camps?

Week-long day camps with lessons and activities centered on STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Math) for a limited number of campers per age group.

(15 max. for grades 1-6; 18 max. for grades 7-9)

Grades 7-9	June 26-30	9:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Cost per Camper Grades 1-6 \$80/week. Grades 7-9 \$125/week.

Cost Includes T-shirt, field trip to Falls of the Ohio, equipment and materials for activities. Students un grades 7-9 must bring a sack lunch each day.



Each week will feature

- Monday** Science education and activities (Biology, Chemistry, Earth/Space, Physics)
- Tuesday** Technology education and activities (Computer Programming, Apps, 3-D Printer, Basic Circuitry)
- Wednesday** Engineering education and activities (Mechanical, Electrical and Civil Engineering)
- Thursday** Math education and activities (Math activities will vary according to age groups, but will support other parts of STEM)
- Friday** Field trip to Falls of the Ohio (Interpretive Center, Fossil Lab, Fossil Hike, Upper and Lower Bed Exploration, Tree and Wildflower Identification)
Please note: Campers will be dropped off and picked up at the Falls of the Ohio on Friday
- Every Day** Each day will feature one STEM career highlight with a guest speaker from a career in that day's featured field.
