Next Wednesday is the Feast of the Assumption of Mary. A Holy Day in the Catholic Church. Grade school students will be attending Mass both on Wednesday and Friday of next week. Mark your calendars to pray the rosary with us on Wednesday, August 15 at 8:00 a.m. in the church before Mass. Also, parents, thank you for cooperating with our request this year to sit with your child’s class while attending our weekly Mass.

I think all of us have noticed a full parking lot at Dismissal. Student safety is our number one concern. Our normal procedure is for parents of students in grades Kindergarten and 1st to meet their child’s teacher while picking up the child. All other parents should stand by their car with the car turned off. **We certainly understand if a parent feels more comfortable meeting his/her child’s teacher before the child is released to the car line. This is perfectly acceptable.** We ask that if this is the preferred procedure for you, please be aware that we would like to release the car lines as efficiently as possible so that we can bring more cars into the parking lot off 8th street. **This is not the time to *conference* with your child’s teacher or *catch-up* on school news with your friends.**

The wisdom of children uplifts and encourages me! When my wife Sandy and I had our children, Lindsey and Lauren at home, we would gather at dinner each night. Sandy had a practice of asking the girls what the best part of their day was. In the past, I often have asked our students that same question. This week, I have changed the question, looking for a more direct answer. *Where did you find Jesus today?* Here are a couple of responses: Presley F. in grade 3, “In religion class, we talked about Jesus in the Apostles Creed; eighth grader, Olivia G. “in my teacher.”

IMPORTANT REMINDERS

TEACHER AVAILABILITY Just a reminder, always be sure to stop in at the office to check on the availability of a teacher if you come to see him/her (before or after school) unexpectedly. Teachers are still interacting with students and preparing for the day during these times, and are not always free to talk, so we need to limit unplanned visits. Of course, we realize there are important exceptions. The best course of action is to leave a message and ask the teacher for a time that works for both of you. **Parents, please also remember we need a phone call to the office to report an absence or send a handwritten note in advance. You may also send an email or voicemail to the teacher in addition to notifying the office.**

CAR RIDERS This week we have continued to observe some potential problems at Arrival and Dismissal. During morning arrival all of us appreciate the attempt for efficiency, but please do not let your children exit your vehicle until you have pulled up to the long sidewalk along the PAC. Second, as most drivers understand, it is important to keep the line flowing at peak times (7:40-7:45am). If your child needs assistance getting out of the car, please do not use the car rider drop off line. It is problematic when drivers put the car in park and get out to assist. The alternative is to come into the church's parking lot from 8th Street. We do appreciate your cooperation pulling up as far as possible along the sidewalk. **At dismissal, cars are not permitted to pull into the church parking lot to turn right onto 8th Street. A more efficient and a safer way to go east on 8th Street is to go left on Martha Dr., then turn left at Walpole Dr. and proceed to Ewing Lane, turn left, and go to traffic light at Ewing Lane to turn right on 8th St.**
