Recently we sent our parents a 60 Second Ultimate Survey asking for feedback on a school calendar and the school day. We received over one hundred responses with more than 60% of our parents responding to start school later in the summer. The New Albany Deanery principals met to discuss the feedback that they received from their parents, teachers, school staff and pastors. Although it was not unanimous, the consensus among the deanery principals was for a deanery calendar. This is the statement from the principals: "To better serve the families in the New Albany Deanery, the Deanery Principals have collaborated at an early date to create a 2019-2020 school calendar. The deanery schools will have a common first day of school, last day of school, and common Fall and Spring Breaks. It is our intent that this common calendar will be beneficial for families that have children in K-12 deanery schools. Please note that the calendar may differ from area public schools."

What this means for Sacred Heart Catholic is that our first day of school will be Wednesday, August 7. Fall break will be October 4-11 and spring break will be March 20-27. Our Christmas break, teacher in-services, other holidays, and the last day of school will be determined in the next several weeks. Our goal is to get the next year's school calendar out by the end of November.
